Striving to improve student transportation, Long County Schools will implement Two Tier Student Transportation for the new school year. Effective August 9, 2013 high school students will no longer be on the bus with elementary and middle school students.

Implementing Two Tier Student Transportation will provide the following benefits for our students:

- Improve student discipline while on the bus.
- Reduce the ride time for all students.
- Enhance the go home process on days when the high school has ball games.
- Operate more efficiently.
- Increase bus ridership at the elementary and middle school level.

Long County Schools will make available transportation staff on Tuesday, July 30 and, Thursday August 1, 2013 to assist parents who need to locate their student's bus number, route, bus stop time and or stop location. Transportation staff will be present at the Long County Middle School cafeteria from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm both days for your convenience.
